- Report any safety concerns or incidents to the appropriate club personnel immediately.

3. Skill Development:

- Provide quality coaching that focuses on skill development, progression, and technique.
- Create a positive and encouraging learning environment for all athletes, regardless of their skill level.
- Continuously seek opportunities to improve your coaching skills and knowledge.

4. Fair Play and Sportsmanship:

- Promote fair play, good sportsmanship, and respect for all participants in the sport.
- Abide by the rules and regulations of the sport and encourage athletes to do the same.

5. Communication:

- Maintain open and honest communication with athletes, parents, and club officials.
- Provide constructive feedback to athletes in a positive and supportive manner.
- Address any conflicts or concerns promptly and professionally, seeking resolution through appropriate channels.

6. Professional Development:

- Engage in ongoing professional development opportunities to enhance coaching skills and knowledge.
- Adhere to the club's policies and procedures, including attending meetings and training sessions.

Disciplinary processes for our paid employees will be carried out as per the conditions of the appropriate employment contract.
